Part II – Assessment PLAN (2007-2008)

A. Intended Outcomes

Students will be able to:

1. Select and use appropriate materials, methods, technologies and processes. (Gen. Ed.)
2. Recognize and apply the elements and principles of art. (Gen. Ed.)
3. Analyze and assess works of art. (Gen. Ed.)
4. Apply historical and contemporary references in works of art. (Gen. Ed.)

B. Identify Assessment Procedures/Methods

1. 12-question quiz, to be administered pre-test and post-test, and measuring Outcomes #2, 3, and 4.
2. Use of rubric for soldering technique to measure students' improvement in this skill (pre-test and post-test). Measures Outcome #1.

C. Benchmarks

- Of the approximately 36 students who will be tested (three sections), it is estimated that 80% will score “C” or better on both instruments.
