

Creative Sketching in Ink Supply List 2009

Sketchbook or paper 11x14 or bigger (60 lb wt)
140 lb cold press watercolor paper
2b pencil
kneaded eraser
Speedball India ink
Vine charcoal
Small bottle of gesso

Dip pen holder
Nibs for pen: B-1, C-1, C-5, C-6 (available at Guiry's)
#10 round watercolor brush or something close (to use with ink)
Another similar brush for water
(script, liner, striper, angle or dagger brush are also fun...)
1 ½" primer brush from Home Depot (99 cents) or any old worn out brush you
may have at home
2 large water containers
a few paper or plastic cups

weird stuff: sticks, sponge, anything you could dip into ink and make an unusual
mark with

newspaper
tissue paper
plastic drop cloth
masking tape
firm board to work on
paper towels
spray bottle

a variety of photos, images or interesting objects that inspire you

optional: white candle
crayons if you have them
watercolors or any other media you have that you might like to play with, with ink
hair dryer
