

CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

This Practical Nurse (PN) certificate is available **only to those students who have been accepted into the registered nursing program** and have completed all prerequisites, the first two semester courses, and NUR 169. The certificate prepares the nursing student to take the practical nursing licensure examination and to practice as a licensed practical nurse. Upon successful completion of the prerequisites, the first and second semester courses listed below, and NUR 169, students will receive a practical nursing certificate. Then they may apply to take the NCLEX-PN (National Council of Licensure Examination-Practical Nursing) exam through the Colorado Board of Nursing.
