Program Admission Requirements

- Attend Interior Design Orientation prior to first registration. Call Interior Design Office at 303-797-5922 to reserve a space.
- Complete ACCUPLACER with minimum scores: 80 on reading, 95 on sentence skills, and 57 on arithmetic.
 - Exceptions to the ACCUPLACER assessment will be made for students who:
 - Achieved equivalent ACT or SAT scores (within the last two years)
 - Have earned a college degree (Associate or higher); OR
 - Have completed mathematics and college-level writing course with a grade of "C" or higher; OR
 - Have completed necessary remedial course(s), if required, with a "C" or higher before taking interior design courses

Note: All course required for this A.A.S. degree must be completed with a "C" or better to meet admission and graduation requirements.
