



First Generation Scholars First Semester Requirements

Below are the requirements for the First Generation Scholarship (1st Semester). The goal is to assist students in establishing the habits and relationships that will ensure their success at Arapahoe Community College and beyond.

- Attend summer retreat.
- Regular meetings (minimum of 6) with academic advisor:
 - Before the start of classes
 - First week of class
 - Prior to census date
 - Prior to midterms
 - Prior to withdraw date
 - Prior to finals
- To improve success, students must enroll in one of the following courses:
 - AAA 101 (Freshman Experience, Section 101 or 102)
 - AAA 090 Section 101 (if testing at the 090 level)
 - SPE 217
 - PLEASE see an advisor for assistance
- Three meetings with instructors during office hours for progress reports. Progress reports to be provided to Academic Advising.
- Involvement in at least one extra-curricular activity sponsored by the college.
- Utilization of the Peer Mentoring and Tutoring Center (as necessary).
- Three meetings with Faculty/Staff Mentor.
- All coursework **must** be completed each semester with a “C” or better; only one probationary semester will be allowed.
- **Failure to meet the above stipulations may result in the loss of the First Generation Scholarship.**
