Every year, ACC nominates up to two students. This competitive scholarship is exclusively for community college students and is worth up to \$30,000 per year for up to three years, a possibility of a **\$90,000** scholarship!

Requirements:

Current ACC student with 30+ credit hours by the end of the fall 2009 semester (or a recent graduate of ACC). Plan to enroll full-time at an accredited 4-year college in Fall 2010. Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. Significant financial need. Demonstrated ability to think and write critically. Demonstrated *will to succeed* with particular emphasis on a history of overcoming a significant challenge to attaining an education. The Thom Sorensen Scholarship

Thom Sorensen was the chair of Behavioral Sciences Department at Arapahoe Community College, and was ACC faculty for 34 of his 36 years in instruction. His special academic interest was in the field of Social Psychology. This scholarship was created to honor his contributions to the Behavioral Sciences Department and to the faculty, staff, and students of the ACC community. The Scholarship amount is \$500!

Requirements:

Enrolled as a part-time or full-time student at ACC. Enrolled in PSY 101 this semester, or has completed it in the past with a grade of B or better. Planning to enroll in PSY 102, 116, 205, 226, 235, 238, or 249 at ACC next semester. Has a cumulative GPA of "B" or better for all PSY courses taken at ACC, and has a cumulative GPA of "C" or better for all courses taken at ACC. The application deadline is November 30, 2009.
