If your program end date has already passed, you are no longer in lawful F-1 status.

Program extensions are approved only for compelling medical reasons or compelling academic reasons. Failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress, academic probation, and academic suspension are not valid reasons for a program extension. Program extensions may be requested for up to 12 months maximum.
