STEP 1: Submit the 2025-2026 FAFSA

- 1. **First time** applicants and contributors: create a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) on studentaid.gov
- 2. Complete student portion of the FAFSA
 - a. Sign in using your FSA ID
 - b. ACC's school code: 001346
 - c. Sign the FAFSA
 - d. Invite contributors to the FAFSA
- 3. Contributors will receive an email from Federal Student Aid (FSA) with instructions to complete and sign their portion of the FAFSA
- 4. Submit the completed FAFSA
- 5. Allow 1-2 weeks for ACC to receive the completed FAFSA

STEP 2: Log into your myACC account

Log in often for any updates from Financial Aid and the Cashier's Office. Look at the following in *Financial Aid*:

- Financial Aid Requirements The US Department of Education may require ACC to collect documents from you to determine your eligibility for financial aid. Check the Financial Aid Requirements section weekly.
- 2. **Award Overview** You will receive an email from us when your financial aid offer is ready to review.
 - a. Choose Award Overview from the links listed
 - b. Click the drop-down menu and choose ACC Aid Year 2025-2026
 - c. Review the Financial Aid Terms and Conditions in the **Terms and Conditions** tab carefully before clicking 'Accept'
 - d. Click on **Accept Award Offer** tab to view/accept/decline your aid offer *Financial Aid will email you if new requirements appear*

STEP 3: Enroll in classes!

You can register for classes while your financial aid is processing. Meet with your Academic Advisor and choose classes required for your degree. Financial aid will only pay toward classes included in your program.

STEP 4: Check your email often!

ACC's Financial Aid Office will send updates to the email address used on the FAFSA until you register for classes at ACC. Once you are registered, your school email address will be activated and we will transition to communicating all information and updates to your student email only. The student email can be accessed via the myACC portal.
