<p>Apply for Financial Aid by completing a FAFSA application at fasfa.gov. The priority deadline is March 1. Check your aid status in myACC on the Student Finance tab. ACC’s school code is 001346.</p>	<p>Financial Aid Office 303.797.5661 finaid@arapahoe.edu</p>
<p>Log into myACC and activate your Student Email Account using your student ID number and password (default password is your six-digit birthday: MMDDYY). Your student ID number, log-in and email instructions are in your acceptance letter. <p>Complete the Accuplacer (placement test). The Accuplacer determines your placement for courses. <p>Register for courses online through myACC. Go to the Student tab and select “Look Up Classes.” Make sure to authorize COF after registration. Be sure to check your schedule a few days before the semester begins to get current room information.</p>	
<p>Contact Student Access Services to request academic accommodations and schedule an intake appointment. Bring documentation of disability and/or diagnosis to your appointment.
